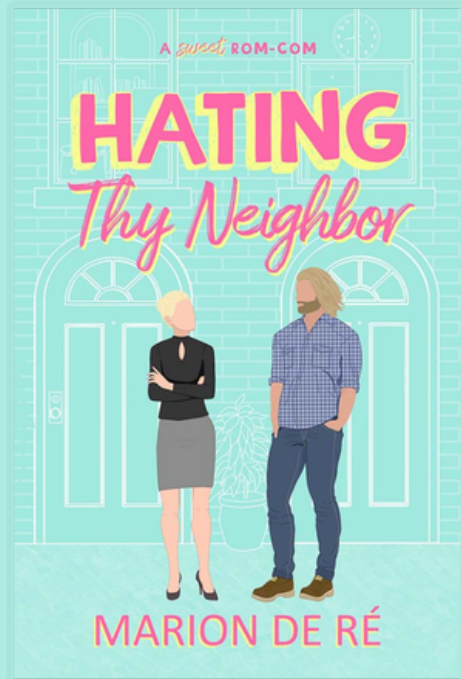

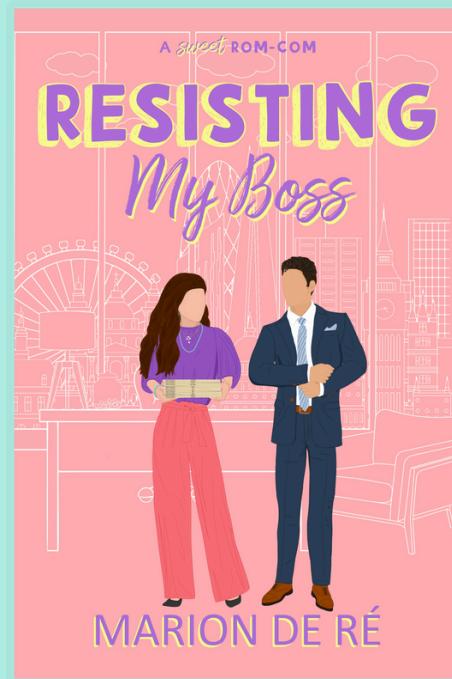
# QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

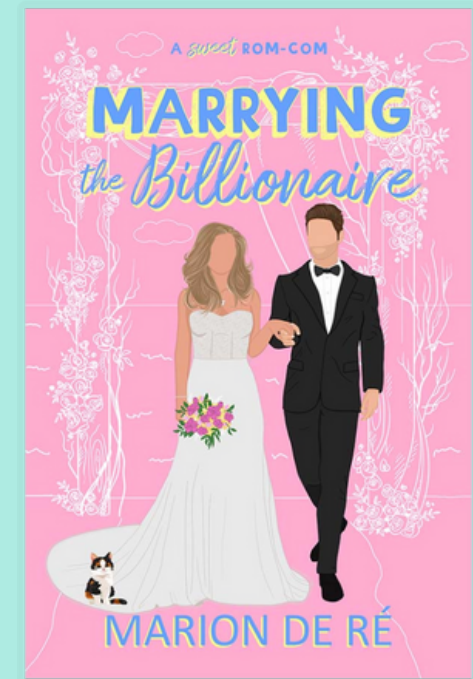
