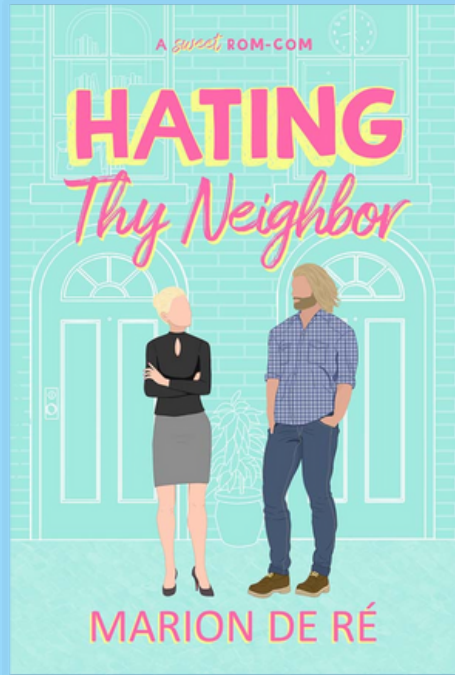

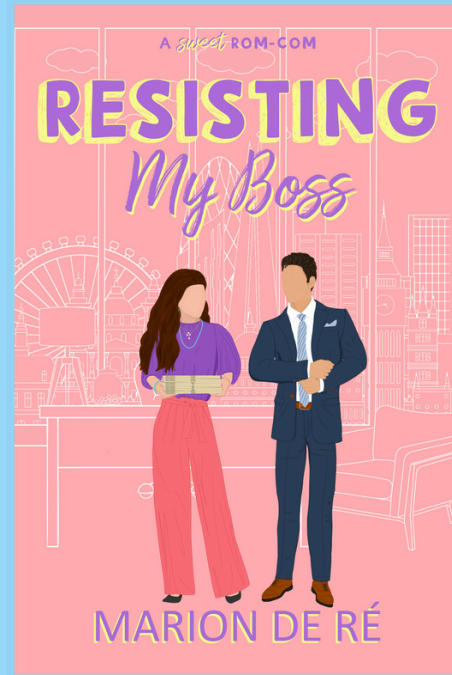
QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

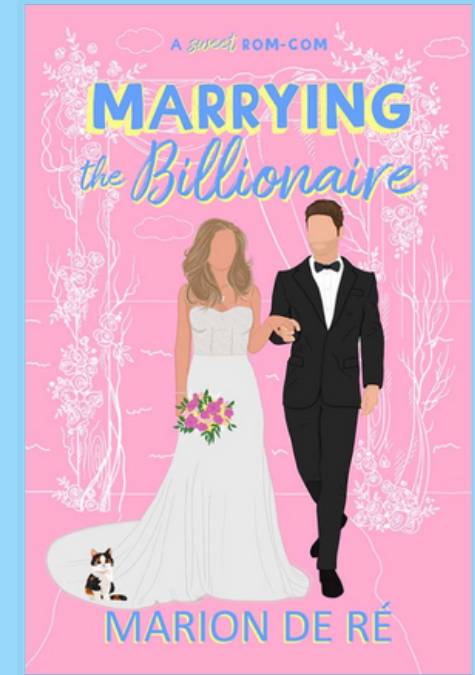
